Some of the original field boundaries (relating to enclosures that were probably set out in the post medieval period) have been retained, which ensures the previous character here remains legible in the present day.

Ridge and furrow shows in the central part of this area on the 2001 and 2005/06 aerial photographs. This may indicated that the piecemeal enclosures consolidated earlier strip fields which would have formed part of an open field system. These strips may have had Saxon/medieval origins.

Bezzles Farm exists in the northern part of this area and is shown on the 1 ed 6" OS map. However, it is too small to map as a separate character area so has been included here.

On balance, the morphology here seems to suggest an orderly division/enclosure of the land, with some variations in form being the result of local watercourses or topography.

No indication on the modern aerial photographs or historic mapping of what the character of the landscape was prior to this very orderly enclosure. No common land existed in this area, nor is there clear evidence of earlier field systems.

The fields here seem more regular and orderly than the others that exist in the nearby vicinity - which are definitely more piecemeal in form.

No hints of prior character can be established from the available sources - with no ridge and furrow or other early character being shown on the modern aerial photographs.
